

Chapter 367.

AN ACT to further amend the act of eighteen hundred and seventy, chapter ninety-eight, entitled "An act to repeal the act of incorporation of Mechanicstown, Frederick county, Maryland," and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to add additional sections thereto.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the commissioners of Mechanicstown may pass all ordinances necessary to preserve the health of the village; to prevent the introduction of contagious diseases; to prevent and remove nuisances; to preserve the peace, order and quiet of the village; to prevent drunkenness; and may pass all such ordinances as may be necessary to promote the good order and welfare of the village of Mechanicstown, not contrary to the laws or constitution of the State of Maryland.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said commissioners shall have power to make such contract with the Mechanicstown water company for the supply of water for the purposes of the corporation, and to erect such fire-plugs and keep the same in repair as they may deem necessary.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the said commissioners may pass ordinances to pave and keep in repair, grade and regrade the streets, lanes and alleys, and to widen the same with the consent of a majority of those interested; to prevent horses, wheelbarrows and other vehicles from passing on or over the footwalks or pavements within the taxable limits; and may tax any particular part or district of the village for paving the streets and lanes, or alleys therein, which may appear for the particular benefit of such part or district.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That the said commissioners shall have full power and authority to grade and pave all sidewalks and gutters, and compel parties on streets already graded within the limits of said corporation to pave such sidewalks or gutters, and from time to time
