who may hold the same, their successors or assigns, and of all persons in interest as lot holders in such ground, whether they are entitled as original lot holders, and whether they be residents or non-residents, adults or infants.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall Effective. take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 370.

AN ACT to refund to Mrs. Jane E. Bunting, of St. Mary's county, the sum of fourteen dollars and seventy-six cents for money erroneously paid into the treasury of the state.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the state be and he is hereby authorized and directed on the warrant of the comptroller, which said comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to draw, to pay to Mrs. Jane E. Bunting, of St. Mary's county, the sum of fourteen dollars and seventy-six cents for money erroneously paid into the treasury of the state in excess of the sum which she owed for state taxes in the years eighteen hundred and eighty-one, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, eighteen hundred and eighty-four, eighteen hundred and eighty-four, eighteen hundred and eighty-five and eighty-four, hundred and eighty-six.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall Effective.
