Chapter 404.

AN ACT to refund to Uzziel Wright a sum of money erroneously paid into the treasury of the state.

Directed to
pay.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the treasurer be and he is hereby directed, upon the warrant of the comptroller therefor, which he is authorized to draw, to pay Uzziel Wright the sum of twenty-six dollars and eighty-four cents, the same being an overpayment into the treasury of Maryland by the said Uzziel Wright as collector of state and county taxes in Charles county for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-three.

Chapter 407.

AN ACT to regulate the heating of steam passenger cars.

Unlawful.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall not be lawful for any steam railroad doing business in the state after the first day of May, eighteen hundred and ninety, to heat its passenger cars by any stove or furnace kept inside of the car or suspended therefrom, except that it may be lawful in case of accident or other emergency to tempo-
