

Chapter 413.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay Wm. S. Taylor and company for lumber furnished for state tobacco warehouse, number two.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the comptroller of the treasury of Maryland be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer of Maryland for the sum of fifteen dollars and twelve cents, which sum is hereby appropriated to pay William S. Taylor and company for lumber furnished to state tobacco warehouse, number two, as per certificate of Augustus Hall, inspector. Appropriation

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

Chapter 414.

AN ACT to incorporate the Maryland Conference of the Church of the United Brethren in Christ.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the ministers, officers and members of the Maryland Conference of the United Brethren in Christ, in the State of Maryland and the District of Columbia, be and they are hereby declared to be a body corporate under the name and style of the "Maryland Conference of the United Brethren in Christ." Incorporated.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said incorporation shall have perpetual succession, and be governed according to the discipline of the church of the United Brethren in Christ and such rules, by-laws and regulations as may, from time to time, be adopted by the Maryland conference of said church, with authority to sue and liability to be sued in any of the courts in the State of Maryland.
