making sale of any of the seed or products named in the foregoing sections of this act by false or fraudulent representations as to its quality or productiveness, or shall sell or offer to sell the same by any artifice or device whereby the purchaser may be deceived, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction or indictment, shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars nor more than five hundred dollars for each offence, or imprisoned in the Maryland House of Correction for not less than six months nor more than two years, or be both fined and imprisoned in the discretion of the court.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 416.

AN ACT to provide for the granting of licenses to brokers in grain in the city of Baltimore.

License.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That any person or partnership applying for the same, and paying the sum of eighteen dollars and seventy-five cents for each individual or representative of such firm or partnership, may obtain a license for carrying on the business of a grain broker.

Repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act be and the same are hereby repealed.

Effective.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
