Repealed and
re-enacted.

AN ACT to repeal section ninety-three of article twenty of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Talbot County," sub-title "Justices of the Peace," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Number of
justices and
constables.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section ninety-three of article twenty of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Talbot County," sub-title "Justices of the Peace," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

Inconsistent
laws repealed.

SEC. 93. *And be it enacted,* That there shall be the following number of justices of the peace and constables in Talbot county, to wit: for election district number one, four justices of the peace and three constables ; for election district number two, four justices of the peace and three constables ; for election district number three, four justices of the peace and three constables ; for election district number four, three justices of the peace and two constables ; for election district number five, three justices of the peace and two constables.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage, and all laws inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
