## Chapter 62.

Repealed and re-enacted.

AN ACT to repeal section ninety-three of article twenty of the Code of Public Local Laws. title "Talbot County," sub-title "Justices of the Peace," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Number of justices and constables.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section ninety-three of article twenty of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Talbot County," sub-title "Justices of the Peace," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Sec. 93. And be it enacted, That there shall be the following number of justices of the peace and constables in Talbot county, to wit: for election district number one, four justices of the peace and three constables; for election district number two, four justices of the peace and laws repealed, three constables; for election district number three, four justices of the peace and three constables; for election district number four, three

the peace and two constables. SEC. 2. And be it enacted. That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage, and all 'laws inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
