AN ACT to enable the qualified voters of the fourth and third election (Pittsburg and Tyaskin) districts, in Wicomico county, to determine by ballot whether chapter eleven of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland. passed at the session of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, entitled "An act regulating fences in Wicomico county, as amended by chapter sixty-five of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled 'An act to repeal sections one and two of an act passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and seventytwo, chapter eleven, entitled 'An act regulating fences in Wicomico county and to re-enact the same with amendments," shall be repealed.

sembly of Maryland, That the question whether or not chapter eleven of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the session of eighteen hundred and seventy-two, entitled "An act regulating fences in Wicomico county, as amended by chapter sixty-five of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled 'An act to repeal sections one and two of an act passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, chapter eleven, entitled 'An act regulating fences in Wicomico county and to re-enact the same with amendments," shall be repealed, shall be submitted to the registered and qualified voters of the fourth and third election (Pittsburg and Tyaskin) districts, of Wicomico county, at the general election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, and the sheriff of said county shall give notice of the time and purpose of said election by advertisement in a newspaper printed in said county, and by hand-bills set up in said election districts of said county; and the expenses of said election, including costs of advertisement, shall be levied
