

**Chapter 66.**

AN ACT to repeal section two and ten of chapter three hundred and thirteen of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled "An act to incorporate the town of Sudlersville, in Queen Anne's county," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section two and ten of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled "An act to incorporate the town of Sudlersville in Queen Anne's county," be repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

Repealed and re-enacted.

SEC. 2. That all persons entitled to vote for delegates to the General Assembly of Maryland, and who have resided within the corporate limits of said town of Sudlersville for six months preceding an election of town commissioners, or who hold taxable property in said town and pay taxes thereon, shall elect by ballot on the third Monday in the month of April in each and every year, three persons residents of said town for the period of six months preceding said election, and entitled to vote for delegates to the General Assembly of Maryland, as commissioners for said town for the ensuing year, or until their successors are elected and qualified.

Who is entitled to vote.

Elect commissioners.

SEC. 10. That the justices of the peace, resident in said town, are hereby declared to be conservators of the peace of said town, and it shall be their duty to order the arrest of any person found breaking the peace or disturbing the quiet and order of said town, or violating any of the ordinances made by the commissioners for securing the safety of the property or lives of the inhabitants of said town, and shall have power to require any person so offending to give security to keep the peace, or in default thereof, may commit such person to the county jail for not more than forty-eight hours, and in addition thereto may for the commission of said offense impose a fine on such person of not more than five

Conservators of the peace.

In default of security may commit.
