penses incurred for opening, constructing. improving or repairing the same shall be assessed against each of said districts respectively, in proportion to the extent of the said road opened, constructed, improved and repaired in each of said districts respectively.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That nothing in this act contained shall in any way relate to or effect the construction, improvement or repair of the public bridges of said county, spanning the navigable waters thereof, but all other public bridges shall be considered as parts of the public roads

in the election districts in which they are respectively located.

Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of passage.

Chapter 453.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendment section three hundred and twenty-three of article ninety-three of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Testamentary Law."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section three hundred and twenty-three of article ninety-three of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Testamentary Law," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

323. In proving a will or codicil, all witnesses Shall be ex-thereto shall be examined, if their attendance can be had.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
