pelling the cars operated on said railways shall not discharge or exhaust any smoke or steam into the open air.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 458.

AN ACT to refund to William E. Hoffman and John W. Hoffman the sum of three hundred and ten dollars, the amount paid by them to the state in error.

Directed to issue.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer in favor of John W. Hoffman for the sum of one hundred and five dollars and ninety-six cents, the amount of taxes paid by him in error to the state.

Directed to

SEC. 2. And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer in favor of William E. Hoffman for the sum of two hundred and four dollars and four cents, the amount of taxes paid by him in error to the state.

Effective.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
