

Chapter 460.

AN ACT to amend the incorporating act of the town of Berlin, Worcester county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the following additional section be added to article twenty-three, Maryland Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Worcester County," to be known as section sixteen A.

Additional section.

Regulations for health, etc.

SEC. 16A. *And be it enacted,* That said commissioners shall have full powers to make such ordinances and regulations as they may deem expedient for the comfort, health and safety of said town, relating to the condition, location and construction of all buildings of whatever kind, whether erected or proposed; and failure to comply with such ordinances and regulations within thirty days after being notified of the same, in writing, shall be punishable by a fine of not less than twenty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars.

Effective.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 461.

AN ACT to change the names of the tributaries of the Choptank river, known as "Harris' creek," to "Harris river;" and "Broad creek," to "Broad river;" to change the name of the tributary of St. Michaels river, known as "Leeds creek," to "Leeds river;" and to change the name of the tributary of Wye river, known as "Skipton creek," to "Skipton river," all in Talbot county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the names of the tributaries or branches of the Choptank river, extending into Talbot county, known as "Harris'
