SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the name of the tributary or branch of the St. Michaels river, known as "Leeds creek," extending into Talbot county, be and the same is hereby changed to "Leeds river," and shall hereafter be called and known by that name. Changed.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the name of the tributary or branch of "Wye river," known as "Skipton creek," extending into Talbot county, be and the same is hereby changed to "Skipton river," and shall hereafter be called and known by that name. Changed.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

### Chapter 462.

AN ACT to refund to James H. Alvey, late collector of taxes for the fifth election district of St. Mary's county, the sum of twelve dollars and ten cents, for money paid into the treasury of the state in excess of the amount due by him for state taxes for eighteen hundred and eighty-five.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the comptroller be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer for twelve dollars and ten cents, to pay James H. Alvey for money paid by him into the treasury as collector of taxes for the fifth election district of St. Mary's county for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-five, in excess of the amount due by him as collector aforesaid. Directed to pay.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.
