License fee.

to provide for the enrollment of said dogs and bitches, and the collection of the tax or license fee thereon; and out of the tax or license fees so collected they may provide for reimbursing owners of sheep or cattle for losses sustained by the killing of sheep or cattle by dogs and bitches other than those owned, kept or harbored by the owner of said sheep or cattle.

Pay bounties.

C. They may make all necessary rules and regulations for allowing and paying bounties for the killing of hawks, owls, crows, minks, foxes, wild-cats and other and like destructive and harmful wild animals and birds.

D. They may make all necessary rules and regulations for the erection or removal of gates and fences across or obstructing the public

highways in their respective counties.

And be it enacted, That all acts or parts of acts of the general assembly, and all articles and sections, or parts of the same, of the Code of Public General Laws or the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, inconsistent with the provisions of this act be and the same are hereby repealed, provided that the provisions of this act shall not apply to Prince George's county.
