defendant or defendants against whom he shall fail to establish his claim had not been joined in the suit.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland be Sanction and the same is hereby given and declared to the granted. bequest of one hundred dollars, contained in the last will and testament of Eliza Mathers, late of Baltimore city, deceased, to the Church of the Ascension, Baltimore, for the use of its Sunday schools.
