SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 495.

AN ACT to provide for the granting of license to real estate brokers in the city of Baltimore, and to regulate the mode of carrying on the business of real estate brokerage in said city.

May obtain
license.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That any person, co-partnership or firm applying for the same, and paying the sum or sums of money herein provided, may obtain a license for carrying on the business of real estate broker in the city of Baltimore, provided that the names of each and every person comprising any co-partnership or firm applying for such license shall be inserted in said license; provided that the sum or sums of money to be paid therefor as aforesaid shall be twenty-five dollars for the first two names inserted in said license, and twenty-five dollars additional for each and every name above two inserted therein.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That any person, co-partnership or firm who shall carry on the business of real estate broker, or shall undertake to
