AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments chapter one hundred and eighty-six of the acts passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and eighty-six, being "An act to repeal and re-enact with amendments chapter four hundred and fifty-five of the acts of January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-four," entitled "An act to repeal section eight hundred and ten of article four of the Code of Public Local Laws," title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Police," and to reenact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That chapter one hundred and eighty-six of the acts passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and eighty-six, being Repealed and "An act to repeal and re-enact with amendments chapter four hundred and fifty-five of the acts passed January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-four," entitled "An act to repeal section eight hundred and ten, article four of the Code of Public Local Laws," title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Police," and to re-enact the same with amendments, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

Power to appoint, etc.

SEC. 810. That the said board of police commissioners be and they are hereby authorized and required, immediately on entering on the duties of their office, to appoint, enroll and employ a permanent police force for the city of Baltimore which they shall arm and equip as they may judge necessary, under such rules and regulations as they may from time to time prescribe; and the said board shall have power to remove any police officer or officers of police, or any detective for the violation of any rule or regulations which they may make and promulgate to said police force, officers of police or detectives; said force shall consist of one marshal and one deputy marshal of police of the city, and one captain, two lieutenants, two turnkeys
