passage of this act, elect a treasurer as herein provided, who shall give bond as herein required.

SEC. 4. And be it further enacted, That the board of county commissioners shall also require the clerk of said board to give bond in the sum of two thousand dollars, with security or securities to be approved by the board, for the true and faithful performance of the duties of his office during the term for which he shall be appointed; and that the county commissioners shall, on or before the first day of July after the passage of this act, elect a clerk to said board of county commissioners, and require him

to give bond as provided in this section.

Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That this act shall

take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 512.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections eleven and twenty-one of article seventy-two of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Partnerships Limited."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General AsRepealed and sembly of Maryland, That sections eleven and
twenty-one of article seventy-two of the Code
of Public General Laws, title "Partnerships
Limited," be and the same are hereby repealed
and re-enacted with amendments so as to read
as follows:

(11). The business of the partnership may be conducted under the name of any one or more of the general partners, and with or without the addition of the word "co." or "company," as the parties may determine; and in any action or suit to be brought on any contract or engagement of the partnership, or to enforce any liability of the same, the general partner whose name is used in said firm or business shall be the only necessary party defendant; and any judgment or decree recovered against said de-

bond, etc.
