

value of fifty dollars each, and that such increase, when made, shall be made in the same manner and under the same provisions of law as the increase to sixty thousand dollars permitted by section three of said chapter one hundred of the act of eighteen hundred and eighty-six.

Extend operations.

SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That the said "The Catonsville Water Company" is hereby empowered to extend its operations to and including Ellicott city, and to within a radius or distance of one-half a mile from the corporate limits thereof; and the said "The Catonsville Water Company" is hereby invested with and is hereby authorized and empowered to exercise and use all the powers, privileges, rights and franchises, and in general to do anything within the corporate limits of Ellicott city aforesaid, and the radius or distance of half a mile therefrom aforesaid, which it is now empowered to do in the village of Catonsville and the first election district of Baltimore county by the provisions of said act of eighteen hundred and eighty-six, chapter one hundred, and that all the provisions of this act and of said chapter one hundred of said act of eighteen hundred and eighty-six be and they are hereby extended to and declared to apply to and to be in force in Ellicott city, within its entire corporate limits, and to within said radius or distance of one-half a mile therefrom as fully as if said Ellicott city and said radius of half a mile had been named therein, and as fully as said act of eighteen hundred and eighty-six, chapter one hundred, now applies to the village of Catonsville and the first election district of Baltimore county therein named.

Where to apply.

Inconsistent acts repealed.

SEC. 12. *And be it enacted*, That all acts or parts of acts, legislative or municipal, inconsistent or in conflict with this act, or any part hereof, be and the same are hereby declared to be inoperative as against this act, or such part hereof, and that when so in conflict, or inconsistent therewith, the provisions of this act shall stand and prevail and be in full force.

Effective.

SEC. 13. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
