not exceeding ten thousand dollars, for procuring and erecting a monument to the memory of Francis Scott Key for the purpose of commemorating his eminent military service and his patriotism while in the defence of his country during the memorable occasion already referred to, in conformity with the appreciation expressed of those services by the resolution of the mayor and city council of Baltimore of March twenty-sixth, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight; and that the mayor and city council of Baltimore are hereby authorized to provide the necessary means for defraying the expenses incidental to carrying this resolution into effect.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall Effective. take effect from the date of its passage.

Whenever at the trial, hearing, or any other stage of an action, suit, petition, cause or matter at law or in equity, it shall appear to the its production court that the attendance or testimony of any person or witness, or the production of any paper, document or thing not produced by any party is necessary to the purposes of justice, the court may require any party to produce such paper, document or thing for inspection by court
