conduct as the board of directors may from time to time require, and the said board of directors shall fix the salaries of such officers

and agents.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted. That whenever any deposit shall be made by any minor the direc-Deposits by tors of said corporation may, at their discretion. pay such sums as may be due to him or her. although no guardian shall have been appointed for such minor, or the guardian of such minor shall not authorize the drawing of the same: and the check, receipt or acquittance of such minor shall be valid as if the same executed by a guardian of such minor, or the said was of full age; provided, such deposit was made personally by said minor; and whenever any deposit shall have been made by a married woman, may repay the same on her own receipt.

same from time to time for the purpose of re-

tions.
