

Chapter 78.

AN ACT to change the name of "South East creek" in Queen Anne's county to "South East river."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the branch of Chester river, now known as "South East creek," extending from said Chester river to Church Hill, in Queen Anne's county, and upon which Beus Point wharf and South East wharf are located, together with its tributaries, be and the same shall hereafter be known as "South East river."

Name of creek changed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 79.

AN ACT to amend the Code of Public General Laws, article forty-three, title "Habeas Corpus," by adding thereto a new section under the sub-title "Procedure in Relation to Minors."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Code of Public General laws, article forty-three, title "Habeas Corpus," be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section, under the sub-title "Procedure in Relation to Minors."

Additional section.

SECTION ... Whenever a minor is brought before a court or judge upon habeas corpus, in private custody, it shall be the duty of such court or judge, in the determination of the case, to be guided by what appears to be for the best interests of such minor in respect to his temporal, his mental and his moral welfare; and, if it be made to appear, to the satisfaction of such court or judge, that such interests would be
