

tion, or corporation for a fish preserve, except for fish hatching purposes.

Non-residents. SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That any justice of the peace of said county, upon receiving sufficient proof that any provision or provisions of this act have been violated by any person being temporarily within said county, but not residing therein permanently, or by any person whose name and residence are unknown, is hereby authorized to issue a warrant for the arrest of such offenders.

Disposition of fines. SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That all fines mentioned in the several sections of this act shall be recovered in the name of the county commissioners of said county; one-half to be paid to the informer, and the other half to be paid to the county commissioners of said county for the benefit of the public schools of said county; provided, that any person feeling himself aggrieved by the judgment rendered by any justice of the peace in any proceedings under the provisions of this act shall have the right to appeal from said judgment to the next term of the circuit court for said county upon entering into a recognizance for his appearance at said term of court.

Shall not apply SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That the provisions of this act shall not apply to the commissioner of fisheries of Maryland, or his agent or agents, nor to the commissioner general of fisheries of the United States, or his agent or agents, such agent or agents shall produce for inspection, his, her or their written authority from said state or United States fish authorities upon demand of any justice of the peace, constable or fish warden; nor shall the provisions of this act apply to waters wholly private; "private water" shall mean, for the purpose of this act, ponds or streams fed wholly by artificial sources, or by springs existing upon the same farm or tract of land belonging to the owner or proprietor thereof, or waters brought by artificial pipes or channels, other natural, into artificial ponds or reservoirs of the owner or owners, or proprietor.

Shall apply. SEC. 12. *And be it enacted*, That the provisions of this act shall to the waters of the Potomac
