SEC. 13. *And be it enacted*, That whenever any examiner or examiners shall be appointed by the county commissioners, as hereinbefore provided for in this sub-title, he or they after taking the oath required by the provisions of this sub-title, before proceeding to collect any assessments made for benefits by him or them, shall file a bond with at least two sureties in double the amount of the sums of money collectable, being the difference between the damages and the
