

the votes cast in favor of such endorsement and against such endorsement were in Talbot county cast in favor of such endorsement to the amount of fifty thousand dollars ; in Dorchester county in favor of such endorsement to the amount of thirty thousand dollars, and in Wicomico county in favor of such endorsement to the amount of twenty-five thousand dollars ; now, therefore—

*Be it resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the aforesaid act, chapter five hundred and nine of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-six, be approved so far as it authorizes the county commissioners of Talbot county to endorse fifty thousand dollars of the second mortgage bonds of the Baltimore and Eastern Shore Railroad Company ; the county commissioners of Dorchester county to endorse thirty thousand dollars of the second mortgage bonds of said Baltimore and Eastern Shore Railroad Company, and the county commissioners of Wicomico county to endorse twenty-five thousand dollars of the second mortgage bonds of said Baltimore and Eastern Shore Railroad Company, said mortgage to be second to a mortgage of five hundred thousand dollars only, and said second mortgage to be limited to two hundred thousand dollars.

Approved conditionally.
