

Chapter 88.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments the second section of chapter four hundred and thirty of the acts of assembly of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled "An act to repeal the first section of the act of January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter three hundred and nine, entitled 'An act to add new sections to article twenty-two of the Code of Public Local Laws of Worcester county, for the protection of partridges,' " and re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the second section of chapter four hundred and thirty of the acts of assembly of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled "An act to repeal the first section of the act of January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-four, chapter three hundred and nine, entitled 'An act to add new sections to article twenty-two of the Code of Public Local Laws of Worcester county, for the protection of partridges,' " and re-enact the same with amendments, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments as follows :

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That no person or persons shall trap or shoot, or in any manner catch or kill any partridges in Worcester county, between the first day of February and the first day of November in each year.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
