CHAPTER 422.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Association of Commission appointed under the provisions of Commission appointed under the Public General Laws of Maryland, Acts of given certain powers. 1896, be and they are hereby authorized and directed to have printed and published, at a cost not to exceed the present contract price per volume, one thousand additional copies of the Records and Histories of the Maryland Soldiers, Sailors and Marines, who fought for the preservation of the Federal Union, 1861-65.

Sec. 2. That the additional copies hereby authorized shall be distributed to the survivors of the civil war of creditable record, or their descendants, and one copy thereof to each and How every member of the General Assembly of Maryland, and said distribution shall be made by the State commissioners appointed under the provisions of Act of 1896, laws of Maryland, chapter 134, with the utmost discretion, after careful investigation of the merits of the applicants therefor.

SEC. 3. That the sum of four thousand dollars or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any approprimoney in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to carry out the provisions of this Act.

SEC. 4. That this Act shall take effect from the date of its Effective. passage.
