ment, or corporation or public officer, or any person or persons acting for others, having the custody of any bonds, stocks, securities, monies or valuables, shall be authorized to deposit the same for safe keeping with said company.

Merchandise, etc., re-ceived upon storage.

SEC. 10. And be it enacted, That said company may receive upon storage, deposit or otherwise, merchandise, specie, plate, bullion, stocks, promissory notes, certificates and evidences of debts, contracts and all other personal property, and advance money thereupon on such terms as may be established or approved by said company; that in all cases in which public officers or municipal or private corporations are authorized to deposit money, stocks, bonds, or evidences of debts, such deposits by such officers or corporations may be made with said company; no loan, however, shall be made to any officer or employe of said company; and for any violation of this provision, the party or parties making or consenting thereto, directly or indirectly, shall be liable to said company for the amount so loaned, and all counsel fees and losses which may result therefrom

Subject to visions.

SEC. 11. And be it enacted, That said corporation be subject at all times to the provisions of the Act of 1892, chapter 109, certain pro- as amended by Act of 1896, chapter 160, to the Act of 1892, chapter 279, and to all general laws applicable to associations of a similar character.

Increase its capital

SEC. 12. And be it enacted, That the company shall have the right at any time to increase its capital stock up to twenty thousand shares of the par value of fifty dollars each; provided the holders of two-thirds of the stock then issued vote in favor of such increase.

Effective.

SEC. 13. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 505.

AN ACT to add an additional Section to the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, Volume 1, Article 4, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Licenses," to be known as No. 668 A, to provide for licenses for stevedores.
