

Various gifts, bequests, etc., sanctioned.

Baltimore, running westwardly, binding on the south side of Baker street two hundred and three feet to the northeast side of Windsor mill road, thence southeasterly binding on said road two hundred and sixty-feet more or less to the intersection of the west side of Monroe street and said road, thence northwardly binding on the west side of Monroe street two hundred feet to the place of beginning, said deed bearing date September 11, 1894, and recorded among the land records of Baltimore city in Liber J.
