

Council of Baltimore, when the same shall mature on the first day of January, 1900, and also to enable the Mayor and City Council to pay and extinguish one million dollars (\$1,000,000) of the stock of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore loaned to the Western Maryland Railroad Company, and falling due on the first day of January, 1902, secured by a covenant of the Western Maryland Railroad Company with the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, bearing date the third day of April, 1872, and recorded among the land records of Baltimore city in Liber G. R. No 561, folio 16, etc., and to provide a sinking fund for the redemption of the stock authorized to be issued by this ordinance," and to ratify and confirm said ordinance, and to confer upon the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore full power and authority to do the several acts mentioned in said ordinance in the manner and upon the terms therein set forth, and to authorize the president and directors of the Western Maryland Railroad Company to do and perform all the acts required by said company to be done by the terms of said ordinance 718

No. 212. An act to add additional sections to the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Harford County," under a new sub-title "Gaming," to follow the sub-title "Fish," and to be known as sections 136 A and 136 B, to follow section 136 of said article 720

No. 213. An act to appropriate a sum of money to meet the additional expenses of the Legislature of Maryland for the session of eighteen hundred and ninety-eight. 721

No. 214. An act to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections 320, 321 and 325 of article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Intoxicating Drinks," and to add a new section to said article, to be designated as section 325 1/2 722

No. 215. An act to amend the charter of the Security Storage and Trust Company of Baltimore City 726

No. 216. An act to add two additional sections to article six of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Caroline County," new sub-title "Clerk to County Commissioners," to come in after section fifty, and to be designated as sections fifty A and fifty B 728

No. 217. An act to add an additional section to article 71 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Ordinary and Inn Keepers and Retailers," to be designated as section 7 729

No. 218. An act to amend Article 27 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishment," sub-title "Rape," by adding a new section to said article, said sub-title to be designated as section 233 A 730

No. 219. An act to provide for the refunding and extension of certain debts of this State, which are now payable or redeemable, or will become redeemable in the years eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, nineteen hundred, nineteen hundred and one, nineteen hundred and three and nineteen hundred and five, in so far as such debts may remain unpaid on the first day of October, eighteen hundred and ninety-eight; and for the issue of State stock or certificates of indebtedness, for the purpose of providing three hundred thousand dollars for the completion of the Maryland penitentiary; eighty thousand dollars for the election of new buildings at the House of Correction; two hundred and twenty thousand dollars for the erection of additional buildings at Second Hospital for the Insane, and three hundred thousand dollars for the purchase of a site and the erection of an armory building for the Fifth Regiment Infantry, Maryland National Guard 731
