and treated at said hospital, free of charge, upon the certificate of the Board of County Commissioners of the several counties of said State of Maryland, and subject to the rules and regulations of said hospital.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 108.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 134 of the Public General Laws of Maryland, Acts of 1896, by making an additional appropriation to complete the publication of the Records and Histories of the Maryland Soldiers, Sailors and Marines, who fought for the preservation of the Federal Union, 1861-65.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sum of thirty-five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be found necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury of Maryland Approprianot otherwise appropriated, for the completion of the Records and Histories of the Maryland Soldiers, Sailors and Marines, who fought for the preservation of the Federal Union, 1861-65.

SEC. 2. That the appropriation authorized by this Act shall be divided as follows, viz: the sum of three thousand dollars shall be available under section 3, and the sum of five hundred How divided. shall be available under the provisions of section 6 of the original Act of which this is an amendment.

SEC. 3. That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

AN ACT to repeal Sections one hundred and seventy-eight, one hundred and seventy-nine, one hundred and eighty and one hundred and eighty-one of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Charles County," sub-title "Taxes."
