Twentieth. Twenty-first. To the bequest contained in the last will and testament of Winefride Martin, late of Baltimore city, deceased, of the sum of three hundred dollars to the Home of the Friendless of Baltimore City for Boys and Girls.

Twenty-second. To the bequest contained in the last will and testament of Winefride Martin, late of Baltimore city, deceased, of the sum of three hundred dollars to the Hebrew Orphan Asylum.

Twenty-third. To the bequest contained in the last will and testament of Winefride Martin, late of Baltimore city, deceased, to the Sister M. Xavier, Queen of the Visitation Convent, corner Park avenue and Centre street, the sum of three hundred dollars.

Twenty-fourth. To the bequest contained in the last will and testament of Winefride Martin, late of Baltimore city, deceased, of three hundred dollars to Sister M. Michal Fitzpatrick of the Carmelite Convent, in trust, for her sister Mrs. Nora F. Whelan and her youngest son, John Whelan, if he needs it.

Twenty-fifth. To the bequest contained in the last will and testament of Winefride Martin of Baltimore city, deceased, of the sum of two hundred dollars to the pastor, for the time being, of St. Thomas' Roman Catholic Church, located at St. Thomas Manor, Charles county, Maryland.

Twenty-sixth. To the bequest contained in the last will and testament of Winefride Martin, late of Baltimore city, deceased, of the sum of one hundred dollars to the pastor, for the time being, of St. Mary Roman Catholic Church, near Bryantown, Charles county, Maryland, and the sum of two hundred dollars
