

a month, and to make such suggestions and alterations as in their judgment they shall deem necessary.

118. Each of said road commissioners shall receive the sum of one hundred dollars, payable annually by the road commissioners out of the road fund, for performing the duties of his office. But upon any charge of malfeasance or misfeasance preferred against them, or any one of them, pertaining to the duties of their office, being sustained, they shall, upon conviction, be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall forfeit the salary then due them, in addition to a fine to be imposed by the court having criminal jurisdiction, in its discretion, and shall lose their office. And the County Commissioners shall appoint some person to fill the vacancy occurring thereby until the next ensuing election for road commissioners. Salary.

119. It shall be the duty of the supervisor, in preparing any road bed where they have to throw up earth to allow proper drainage, to make such places in said roads wide enough for two vehicles to pass each other, and to remove and keep clear all obstructions at least fifteen feet from the centre of said roads, and to require all owners to move their fences which infringe on said roads fifteen feet from the centre of the same. Width of road bed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

CHAPTER 183.

AN ACT to repeal and re enact Section 27 of Article 56 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Licenses," sub-title "Hawkers and Peddlers," so far as the same applies to Prince George's County, Maryland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section 27 of Article 56 of the Code of Public General Laws, (so far as the same applies to Prince George's county,) title "Licenses," sub title "Hawkers and Peddlers," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows : Repeal.

27. No hawker or peddler shall buy for sale out of the State. or buy to trade, barter or sell, or offer to trade, barter or sell within the State any goods, wares or merchandise, until he shall have first taken out a license for that purpose; but nothing in this section shall apply to hawkers or peddlers of oysters and fish in their unpreserved and natural condition, or of fruits, License to be taken out.
