SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That the Governor of the State be and he is hereby authorized and directed to appoint a commission of five citizens of this State, who shall serve without compensation, and whose duty it shall be, or that a majority of commission them, to take all needful steps and do all lawful acts to carry into effect the provisions of this Act; provided, however, that the cost of said statues including the pedestals thereof and the transportation and other charges and expenses connected with placing said statues in said Hall of Statuary shall not exceed the amount hereby appropriated.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer, payable to the order of the Appropriasaid commissioners, or of a majority of them, for such sum or sums and at such time or times as shall be required by the draft or order of the said commissioners, or of a majority of them, within the amount so hereby appropriated, for the modeling, construction, transportation and erecting of said statues.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That the said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall make full report and account to the Governor, to be submitted to the next General Assembly, of Make report. and concerning their proceedings and expenditures in the premises.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections 5, 6, 7 and 8 of Article 43 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Health," sub-title "State Board of Repeat Health," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted
