- 42. To the Home for Confederate Mothers and Children, the sum of three thousand dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety nine, and the like sum of three thousand dollars for the fiscal year nineteen hundred.
- 43. To the hospital for Relief of Crippled and Deformed Children of Baltimore, Maryland, the sum of three thousand dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, and the like sum of three thousand dollars for the fiscal year nineteen hundred.
- 44. To the Aged Men and Women's Home of the Methodist Episcopal Churches of the Washington Annual Conference of the City of Baltimore, the sum of five hundred dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, and the like sum of five hundred dollars for the fiscal year nineteen hundred.
