

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That hereafter it shall not be lawful for the clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick county to issue a license or licenses to any person or persons or body corporate, to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer in the village of Jefferson, in Frederick county, or at any place in said county within two miles of the corporate limits of said village of Jefferson. Unlawful to issue license to sell liquor within certain bounds.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

#### CHAPTER 338.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Mortgage Loan and Guarantee Company, as incorporated by Chapter 357 of the Acts passed at the January session of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1896, by repealing and re-enacting with amendments Section 12 thereof, and by adding one section thereto to be designated as Section 4, to follow Section 3 of said Act.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section 2 of chapter 357 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session of 1896, be and the same is hereby repealed and re enacted with amendments as hereinafter set forth, and that one new section be and the same is hereby added thereto, to be known as section 4, to follow section 3 of said Act, and that said new section shall read as hereinafter set forth: Repeal.

2. *And be it further enacted,* That the capital stock of said body corporate shall consist of one thousand shares of the par value of one hundred dollars each. Capital stock.

*And be it further enacted,* That the name of the said body corporate be and the same is hereby changed from the Mortgage Loan and Guarantee Company to the "Monumental Banking and Trust Company." Name changed.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

#### CHAPTER. 339.

AN ACT authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Cumberland to make an annual levy in aid of the Board of Trade of said City.
