CHAPTER 353.

AN ACT to repeal Section 162 A of Article eight of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Cecil County," sub-title "Fish," as enacted by Chapter 256 of the Acts of Assembly of 1890, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section 162 A of Article eight of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Cecil County," sub-title "Fish," as Repeal. enacted by chapter 256 of the Acts of Assembly of 1890, be and the same is hereby repealed and re enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows:

162 A. It shall be lawful for any one who is a resident of this State, or rent a shore within the limits of Cecil county, to fish with a seine having a mesh not less than one and a quarter Laweregulatinches square when knit, in the Sassafras, Elk, North East and inginishing. Bohemia rivers, and on the shore from Carpenter's Point to Poplar Point, within the limits of Cecil county, from the tenth day of June to the first day of October next ensuing each year.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 354.

AN ACT to repeal Sections 200 and 202 of Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Mayland, title "Montgomery County," sub-title "Rockville," and to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 192, 193, 194 and 195 of said Article, and to add certain new sections thereto, to be numbered 193 A, 193 B, 193 C, 193 D and 193 E.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections 200 and 202 of Article 16 of the Code of Repeal. Public Local Laws of Maryland, titled "Montgomery County," sub-title "Rockville," be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That sections 192, 193, 194 and 195 of said Article 16 be and the same are hereby repealed Repeal. and re-enacted to read, in connection with five new sections, to
