

vided is prohibited; "city," "town" or "village" shall mean an incorporated city, town or village, as the case may be. "Political Sub-division" shall mean "county, election district, city, town, village or ward." District shall mean "territory in which, after the same has become Anti-Saloon Territory, the limits of the political sub-division have been changed." Law shall include Public General Laws, Public Local Laws and all municipal ordinances. In the phrase "shall this become Anti-Saloon Territory" the proper designation, whether "county," "election district," "city," "town," "village" or "ward" shall be understood to be inserted in the blank, and the same shall be inserted in the petitions filed by and the ballots prepared for the voters of any county, election district, city, town, village or ward. Said proposition shall mean the proposition: "Shall this (county, election district, city, town, village or ward, as the case may be) become Anti-Saloon Territory." "Supervisors of Elections" shall mean the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Washington county; "legal voter" or "voters" shall mean a duly registered legal voter. "Election" shall mean an election held on Tuesday next after the first Monday in November in any year. "Court" shall mean the Circuit Court for Washington county, and "Judge" shall mean a judge of said court. "Intoxicating Liquor" shall include whiskey, brandy, rum, gin, wine, ale, beer and all other fermented, distilled, spirituous, vinous or malt liquors, and every mixture of liquors which shall contain more than two per cent. by weight of alcohol, and every mixture of liquors which shall contain less than two per cent. of alcohol if the same shall be intoxicating.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That upon the filing in the office of the Supervisors of Elections at least sixty days before an election of a petition as in this Act provided, directed to such Supervisors of Elections, containing the signatures of legal voters of any political sub-division in number not less than one-fourth of the total vote cast in such political sub-division at the last election therein, to submit to the voters of such political sub-division the proposition "shall this become Anti-Saloon Territory?" Said proposition shall be submitted at such election, as in this Act provided, to the legal voters of such political sub-division, and if a majority of the legal voters voting upon said proposition shall vote "yes," such political sub-division shall become Anti-Saloon Territory, such petition shall be a public document and shall be subject to the inspection of the public.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That a vote under the provisions of this Act shall become operative on the first day
