intersection of the northeast corner of Union avenue and Congress avenue, in the city of Havre de Grace, Maryland, to be applied to the debt on the new St. Patrick's Roman Catholic Church, Havre de Grace, Maryland, in such manner and at such time as he may deem most advantageous."

- 19. To two deeds and grants by James M. Smith and wife to the Trustees of Trinity Methodist Episcopal Church of East New Market, Dorchester county, Maryland, a body corporate, duly incorporated under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Maryland, of a lot of ground, situate, lying and being near the town of East New Market, Dorchester county, Maryland, one of which said deeds bears date the twenty-third day of October, 1888, and is recorded in the Land Records of Dorchester county, in Liber C. L., No. 13, page 567, and the other deed bears date the thirtieth day of December, 1907, and is recorded in the Land Records of Dorchester county, in Liber C. L., No. 33, page 573.
