SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 89.

AN ACT for the relief of the Maryland Asylum and Training School for Feeble Minded and to make appropriations therefor.

WHEREAS, An addition has just been completed to Pembroke Cottage at said institution, capacity for 50 additional inmates, and is now ready for occupancy, but no appropriation has been made for equipping and furnishing the same, or for the support of its inmates; and,

Whereas, An indebtedness has been incurred by its board of visitors for extraordinary and unavoidable necessary expenses.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sum of eighteen thousand five hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated for the relief of the Maryland Asylum and Training School for Feeble Minded, payable out of any funds in the Treasury available for that purpose; eight thousand five hundred dollars thereof to be expended in the equipping and furnishing the addition to Pembroke Cottage and support of fifty additional inmates therein during the fiscal year ending September, 1908, and ten thousand dollars to pay the present indebtedness of said institution; and the Comptroller of the Treasury is hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the Treasurer of this State for said appropriation immediately after the passage of this Act.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 103.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Article 65 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland (Code 1904), as enacted by Chapter 89 of the Acts of the General Assem-
