

of the regiment, company or separate organizations, be deposited in the armory of the said regiment, company or separate organization, and failure to deposit as aforesaid any article of such property by the person to whom it was issued, ten days after he shall have been notified, by written notice from the commanding officer as aforesaid to return it to the armory, shall be considered as a misdemeanor, and the person so offending shall be punished by a fine not exceeding double the value of the property thus illegally detained, to be recovered on the complaint of the Adjutant General or of the proper commanding officer as aforesaid, in the same manner as prescribed for the collection of fines in Section 65 of this Act, except that the money so recovered shall be paid to the Adjutant General of the State, to be by him applied to the militia fund, or by imprisonment in the county or city jail for not less than two weeks nor more than two months.

SEC. 77. Each officer and enlisted man ordered for duty by the Governor, or under his authority by the commanding officer of the Brigade or the Naval Brigade, shall receive the pay herein specified for every day actually on duty. Officers, according to their rank, shall be entitled to pay at the same rate per diem that officers of like rank receive in the service of the United States, including longevity pay. Enlisted men shall be paid the following rates per day: Non-commissioned staff officers, first sergeants and company quartermaster sergeants, two dollars; sergeants, one dollar and seventy-five cents; corporals, cooks and farriers, one dollar and fifty cents; musicians and privates, one dollar and twenty-five cents; enlisted men of the Naval Brigade, one dollar and twenty-five cents, except the chief and petty officers, who shall be paid as follows: Chief petty officers, two dollars and twenty-five cents; first class petty officers, two dollars; second class petty officers, one dollar and seventy-five cents; and third class petty officers, one dollar and fifty cents. And, in addition to said pay, each enlisted man shall receive rations as prescribed by the regulations of the United States Army and United States Navy, respectively, or commutation thereof at a rate not exceeding forty cents per day; each enlisted man who has served a full term of enlistment, and who re-enlists within thirty days of the expiration of this previous enlistment, shall receive an increase of ten per cent. of his pay during this enlistment, and for each full term of enlistment served thereafter an increase of ten per cent. will be granted, until forty per cent. is reached.

SEC. 78. All enlisted men who qualify in accordance with the requirements of the course prescribed by order of the Governor and Commander-in-Chief in small arms practice shall be
