

CHAPTER 499.

AN ACT to add a new section to follow section 517 of article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Charter," as re-enacted by Act of 1906, chapter 469, such additional section to be known as section 517B, and to give authority to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to make appropriations for repairs, permanent improvements and additions to the buildings and grounds of the Saint Mary's Industrial School for Boys of the City of Baltimore, and its successors.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new section be added to follow section 517 of article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Charter," as re-enacted by Act of 1906, chapter 469, said additional section to be known as section 517B and to read as follows:

517B. The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore are further authorized and empowered to appropriate for repairs, permanent improvements and additions to the buildings and grounds now used or hereafter to be used by the Saint Mary's Industrial School for Boys of the City of Baltimore and its successors, such additional sum or sums of money as in their judgment shall from time to time be required for those purposes.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 162.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Code, section 604A of article 4 of the Public Local Laws, entitled "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Miscellaneous Laws," as the same was enacted by Chapter one hundred and sixty-four of the Acts of 1900 of the General Assembly of Maryland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Code, section 604A of article 4 of the Public Local Laws, entitled "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Miscellaneous Laws," as the same was enacted by chapter one hundred and sixty-four of the Acts of 1900, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:
