682. No licensee under the sub-division of this article holding any other than a hotel license, shall sell or furnish to any person intoxicating liquors on any day upon which elections are now, or may hereafter be required by law to be held nor on the Lord's Day, commonly called Sunday; no licensee under the sub-division of this article holding any other than a hotel or a club license shall sell or furnish to any person intoxicating liquors between the hours of twelve midnight and five o'clock A. M., nor in any place to which an entrance shall be allowed other than directly from a public-traveled way. shall any such licensee holding a hotel license sell or furnish any such intoxicating liquors on said prohibited days, except to bona fide registered guests to be drunk in their rooms or at their meals, nor shall any club licensees sell or furnish such liquors to any person at any time between the hours of one o'clock A. M. and five o'clock A. M. on any day. And provided, further, that any licensees under the sub-divisions of this article may with the permission of the Board of Police Commissioners at any bona fide entertainment of any society, club or association, sell intoxicating liquors between such hours as the board aforesaid may designate in such permit.

## CHAPTER 197.

AN ACT to repeal section 669 of article 4, entitled "City of Baltimore," of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, sub-title "Liquors and Intoxicating Drinks," as the same now stands, and to re-enact the same with amendments and to add two additional sections thereto, to be known as sections 690A and 690B.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section 669, article 4, entitled "City of Baltimore," of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, sub-title "Liquors and Intoxicating Drinks," as the same now stands, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, and two additional sections, to be known as sections 690A and 690B, be and the same are hereby added so as to read as follows:

669. Said board shall appoint such clerk or clerks and counsel as the proper transaction of the business of the board shall require, and shall keep a full record of all applications for licenses, of all recommendations for and remonstrances against the granting of licenses, and their action thereon; and the vote
