

completion of their work, and the Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the treasurer for the payment of the said sum of two thousand dollars to each member of said Commission whenever he shall be satisfied that the work of said Commission has been faithfully and honestly performed; and the sum of two thousand dollars, in addition to the compensation of the Commissioners, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses of said Commission in printing, clerical service and the like, which sum the Treasurer shall pay to said Commission in instalments upon the warrant of the Comptroller from time to time as requested by said Commission; and the Treasurer shall likewise, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, pay the compensation of said Commissioners as hereinbefore provided.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

ARTICLE XXX.

DEAF, DUMB AND BLIND.

CHAPTER 566.

AN ACT to establish a workshop for the employment of blind men and women, and making an appropriation therefor.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That there shall be maintained in Baltimore city, Maryland, a workshop for the blind.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That general supervision and control of said workshop shall be vested in a board of five trustees, three of whom shall be appointed by the Governor, by and with the advice of the Senate, and two shall be elected by the board of directors of the Maryland School for the Blind; and the term of the members of said board shall be for a period of two years from the date of their appointment, or until their successors shall have been appointed and qualified, and whenever a vacancy shall occur on said board it shall be filled for the unexpired term by vote of the said members of the board remaining.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That said board of trustees shall constitute a body corporate under the name and style of "The
