Any person convicted of a second or additional offense under this section shall be subject to imprisonment for not less than six months nor more than two years.

DISCOUNT TO CHAUFFEURS PROHIBITED.

157. No chauffeur or other person having the care of a motor vehicle for the owner shall receive or take, directly or indirectly, any bonus, discount, or other consideration for supplies of parts furnished or purchased for such motor vehicle, or any work or labor done thereon by others, or on the purchase of any motor vehicle for his employer; and no person furnishing such supplies or parts, work or labor, selling any motor vehicle shall give or offer any such cauffeur or other person having the care of a motor vehicle for the owner, directly or indirectly, any bonus, discount or other consideration thereon. Any person violating any provision of this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and subject upon conviction to a fine of not less than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the first offense.

PART V

ENFORCEMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS

ARREST, BAIL, TRIAL AND APPEAL.

158. In case any person shall be taken into custody because of a violation of any of the provisions of this sub-title, he shall forthwith be taken in the counties of this State before the nearest Justice of the Peace, committing Magistrate or Police Justice, or if in Baltimore City before the Justice of the Peace of the Traffic Court, and be entitled to an immediate hearing; and if such hearing cannot then be had, he shall be released from custody on giving bond or undertaking executed by a fidelity or surety company authorized to give such bonds in this State, or by a person or persons acceptable as surety or sureties by said magistrate or police justice, such bond or undertaking to be in an amount equal to the maximum amount prescribed
