

signees, devisees or heirs shall be entitled to a patent thereon; or if the certificate is released by adjudication or by operation of law from the effect of the caveat, a patent shall issue thereon as if no caveat had been filed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from and after the first day of June, 1918.
