

## CHAPTER 38.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Baltimore County to pay to May Creamer, widow of John Wesley Creamer, a former Police Lieutenant of Baltimore County, a pension of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per month.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Baltimore County are hereby authorized and directed to pay to May Creamer, the widow of John Wesley Creamer, a former Police Lieutenant of Baltimore County, the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) each month, payable on the last day of each month, during the term of her natural life, or so long as she shall remain unmarried,—said pension to terminate upon her death or remarriage; and for that purpose they are hereby authorized and empowered to levy annually the sum of Three Hundred Dollars.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act is hereby declared to be emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and being passed upon a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.
