may in its discretion remand said case to the said County Commissioners for alteration, correction or amendment. All persons so appealing, or against whom such appeal is taken, shall have the right to a trial by jury of all issues of fact involved in such appeal as fully and in same manner as though the case had originated in the said court.

177U. Said Commissioners shall have the power to require all notices provided by this sub-title to be given, or which it may be necessary to give in the course of any of the proceedings, to be served by any of the constables of the Montgomery County, and to allow the sum of forty cents and no more for the service of every such notice; and any constable failing to serve any such notice or making any false return as to such service, shall be punishable as for other similar violations of duties required by law to be performed by him.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety, and being passed upon a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 230.

AN ACT to repeal Section 167A of Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, title "Montgomery County," sub-title "Roads," as the same was amended and enacted by Chapter 108 of the Acts of 1912 and to re-enact the same with amendments, providing for levy by the Board of County Commissioners of monies for repairing dirt, macadam or other permanently improved roads, the allotment to and expenditure of the same by Election Districts, the expenditures of other monies; also providing for a general fund for re-surfacing permanently improved roads, and for construction of permanently improved roads, and certain requirements of vouchers for said expenditures.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 167A of Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, title "Montgomery Coun-
