A., No. 12, folio 129, etc.

48. To the devise contained in the "tenth" item or clause of the Last Will and Testament of Emily H. Berry, late of Baltimore City, deceased, which Will is recorded in the office of the Register of Wills of Baltimore City, in Wills, Liber H. W. J., No. 109, folio 159, etc., wherein there was given and devised to the said Women's Foreign Missionary Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church, the annuity or yearly rent of four hundred dollars, issuing and payable out of a lot of ground in Baltimore City, situate on the north side of Pratt Street, beginning 82 feet 11½ inches west from Green Street, and running thence westerly on Pratt Street fifty feet, with an even northerly depth of one hundred and eighty feet to King Street.

Berry, late of Baltimore City, deceased, to the Woman's Foreign Missionary Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church, said Deed dated April 18th, 1911, and recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore City, in Liber S. L., No. 2659, folio 380, etc., wherein the annuity or yearly rent of four hundred dollars, particularly described in said deed, was conveyed to the Woman's Foreign Missionary Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church by Thomas J. Morris, executor, under the
