

shall not be sold at private sale for less than par and accrued interest.

SEC. 5. *And be it further enacted,* That the actual cash proceeds of the sales of certificates of indebtedness under this Act, shall be paid to the Treasurer upon the warrant of the Comptroller, and such proceeds shall be used, as far as required for such purpose, for the redemption and payment of the certificates of indebtedness issued under the Act of 1917 Chapter 3 aforesaid.

SEC. 6. *And be it further enacted,* That the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated for the payment of the expenses of engraving, printing, advertising and other outlays connected with the issue of the loan hereby authorized, and for all other preliminary expenses connected with the execution of the provisions of this Act; the same to be paid by the Treasurer upon the warrant of the Comptroller.

SEC. 7. *And be it further enacted,* That the County Commissioners of the several Counties of this State and the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, are hereby respectively directed to levy the State taxes for the years 1919 and 1920 of one-third of one cent ($\frac{1}{3}$ of 1 cent) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) of assessable property, and for the year 1921 and annually thereafter to and including the year 1933, at seven-eighths of one cent ($\frac{7}{8}$ of 1 cent) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) of assessable property, to be collected according to law, to meet the interest on the amount of said certificates of indebtedness issued and outstanding under this Act, and also to meet and redeem so much of the principal thereof, in each of said years, as will be represented by the certificates redeemable in each year, respectively, as herein specified in Section 2 of this Act.

SEC. 8. *And be it further enacted,* That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency law and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and being passed upon a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.
